

## Reference for Mr. Adrian Letzner

Mr. Adrian Letzner, born on May 8 1985, has worked several times as consultant for the water and sanitation program (PEP/ProSEHA) of the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) in Benin between 2014 et 2016.

At the beginning of 2014 Mr. Letzner outlined the methodology to assess the quality of drinking water in communes. The assignment was part of the Drinking Water and Sanitation Program (PEP).

Between end of 2014 and 2016 Mr. Letzner supported the development of a self-test under the Water, Hygiene and Sanitation Program (ProSEHA). This test allowed the households themselves to detect the presence of coliform bacteria in their drinking water.

Mr. Letzner accomplished his tasks to the satisfaction of GIZ and the Directorate for Public Health (DNSP) of the Ministry of Health. Mr. Letzner adapts easily to both rural and urban working conditions. His good command of French allowed him to easily work with the Beninese partners.
